

Dental Insurance Programs

For Children:

Through Florida **Kidcare**, the state of Florida offers health insurance for children from birth through age 18 even if one or both parents are working. It includes 4 different parts.

When you apply for the insurance, Florida KidCare will check which part your child may qualify for based on age and family income. (Most families pay \$15 - \$20 a month or nothing at all).

1. **MediKids** - Children ages 1- 4.
2. **Healthy Kids** - Children ages 5 - 18.
3. **Children Medical Network Services** - Children birth - 18 who have special health care needs.
4. **Medicaid** - Children birth - 18. A child who has other insurance may still qualify for Medicaid.
